The verbs was and were tell about the past.

We are going to use **WAS** in singular with I, he, she, it.

Examples:

I **was** happy yesterday.
He **was** hungry last night.
She **was** a nurse last year.
It **was** big.

We are going to use **WERE** in plural with we, you, they.

Examples:

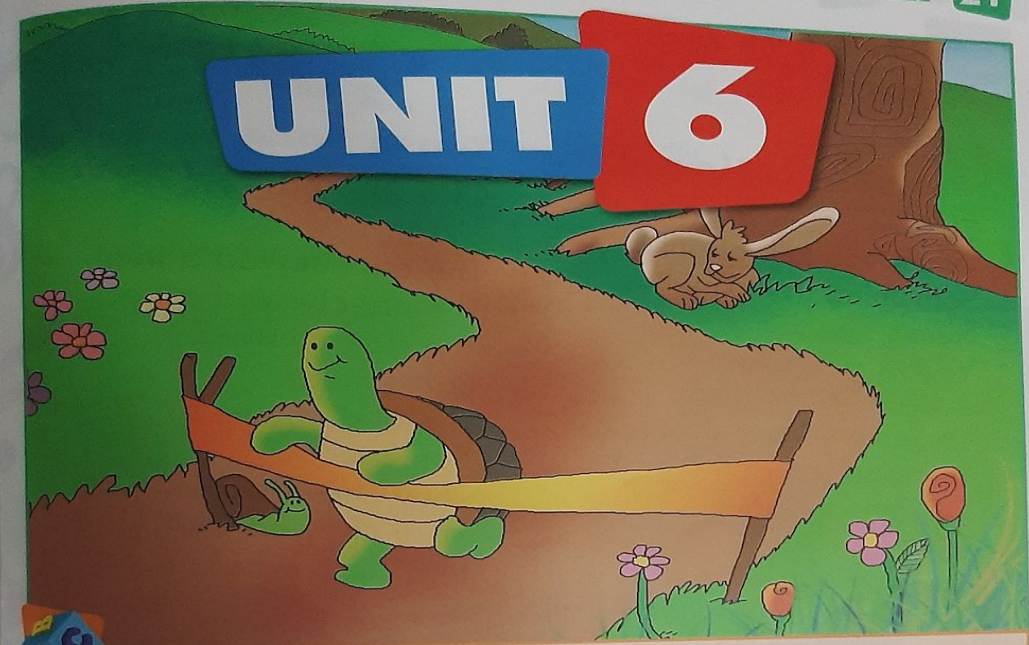
We **were** early yesterday.
You **were** at school in January.
They **were** quiet last week.

The verbs **was** and **were** tell about the past. They are the past of the verb **be**.
Use **was** to tell about one person, animal, place, or thing.
Use **were** to tell about more than one person, animal, place, or thing.

This is a story about a tortoise and a hare. They decided to have a race. The tortoise was slow but steady. The hare was fast, but he was not smart. The tortoise finished the race first. He was happy and the hare was sad. The lesson we learn from the tortoise is that it is better to be steady than fast.
