Pronouns

<p style="text-align: center;">SUBJECT PRONOUNS I, you, he, she, it, we, they.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">OBJECT PRONOUNS me, you, him, her, it, us, them.</p>
<p>Used as the subject of the sentence. We use them in place of the nouns representing people, places, animals or things.</p> <p>Examples: Jeremy likes basketball He likes basketball. </p> <p>Ana speaks very quickly She speaks very quickly. </p>	<p>Use an object pronoun after an action verb or prepositions such as for, at, of, on, with, in and to. Object pronouns usually appear near the middle or end of the sentence (after the verb) and tell what or who is receiving the action of the sentence.</p> <p>Examples: I like horses I like them. </p> <p>I will go to the party with Sam I will go to the party with him. </p>


