Are sometimes called short forms, commonly combine a pronoun or noun and a verb.

Examples:

I am - I'm ready for a vacation.

They wil - They'll play soccer.

Remember:

Possessive Adjectives:

Take the place of a possessive noun.

my, your, his, her, its, our, your, their.

Examples:

My pencil case is pink.

Your name is Daisy.
