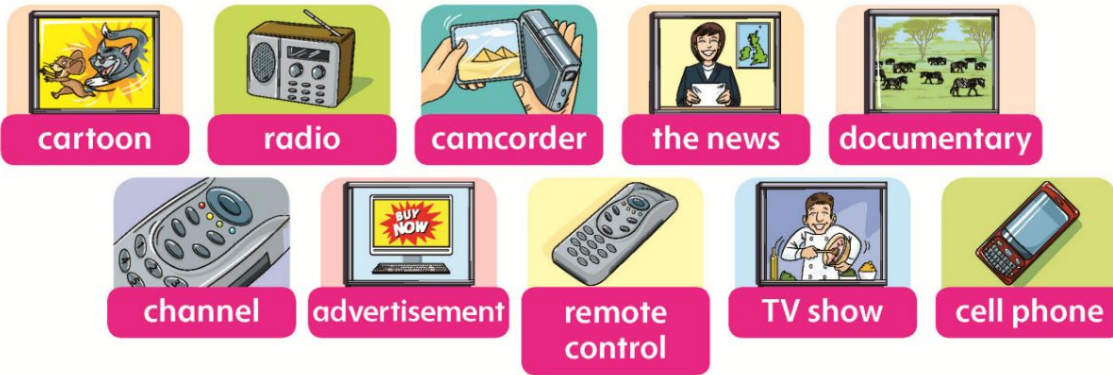

Infinitive of purpose

I turned on the TV **to watch** sports.
We went in the boat **to see** the dolphins.

Use **to + the base form** of the verb for a purpose or a reason.
to + base form = infinitive (e.g., *to watch*)
