Comparative Adjectives

Comparative adjectives compare two or more things.

Add **-er** to most one- and two-syllable adjectives to compare two people, places, or things.

quiet → **quieter**

For adjectives that end with **-y**, change the **y** to **i** and add **-er**.

happy → **happier**

For adjectives that have more than two syllables, use the word **more** to compare the things.

dangerous → **more dangerous** interesting → **more interesting**

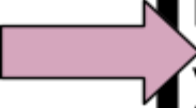
