Yes/No and Wh - Questions

- Yes/No questions start with **Do, Does or Did**. To reply to a Yes/No question, use **yes** or **no** in the answer.

Example: Do you see the dentist twice a year.?

Yes, I do.

Example: Does Ryan exercise regularly?

No, he doesn't.

- Wh - questions use the following question words: **Who, When, Why, What, Where, How**.
These questions ask for some kind of information and do not use a yes or a no answer in their reply.

Example: Who is your doctor?

Answer: Dr. Smith is my doctor.

Example: Where does he work?

Answer: He works at the mail.
