FUTURE TENSE WILL

Use will to talk about the future. Use Will when you are not sure about a future action.

EXAMPLES:

I will probably study Math.

We will go on vacation with our parents.

NEGATIVE FUTURE -WON'T

The negative contraction for will not is -won't.

EXAMPLES:

I will not drink soda.

I **won't** drink soda.

They will not watch a movie.

They **won't** watch a movie.

QUESTIONS FUTURE TENSE

To make a question only change the verb with the auxiliary form. We can use the WH QUESTIONS.

EXAMPLE:

You will take a shower.

Will you take a shower?

When will she go home?

What will you do?

Future Tense Will / Won't

Week 25

Use the subject pronoun + 'll to make an affirmative contraction.
I will see you at 2:00. → I'll see you at 2:00.
They will come with us. → They'll come with us.

The negative contraction for **will not** is **won't**.
She will not take a train. → She **won't** take a train.
We will not have a vacation. → We **won't** have a vacation.


Week 25 **Future Tense Will / Questions**
