Remember, the **present perfect tense** tells about an action that began in the past and is still happening. It is formed with **have/has** + past participle. Paul **has read** many stories about sea explorers.

The **past perfect tense** describes a past action that happened before another past action. It is formed with **had** + past participle. Before the Polos, explorers **had failed** to find a route overland to China.
