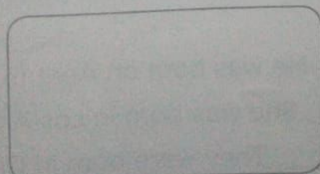

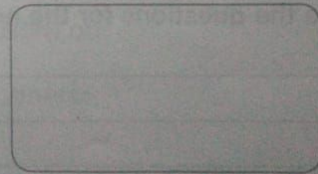

Use **was** with **I**, **he**, **she**, and **it**. Use **were** with **you**, **we**, and **they**. You can use a question word before **was** or **were**.

I **was born** in Florida.

Use **in** before a country, city, or town. Use **in** before a month or year. Use **on** before a day or a date.
