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Week 29 **Present Perfect Tense**

Use the **present perfect tense** to talk about an action that began in the past when the fact that it happened is more important than when it happened. To form the present perfect tense use subject + **have/has** + past participle.

The **past participle** is usually formed by adding **-ed**, but some past participles are irregular.

The space shuttle **has orbited** the moon.
The astronaut **has gone** to space three times.

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
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Past Perfect Tense **Week 30**

Use the **past perfect tense** to express an action completed in the past before another past action. To form the past perfect tense use subject + **had** + past participle.

Robert **had visited** the National Air and Space Museum in Washington D.C. before he visited the Lyndon B. Johnson Space Center in Houston.
