Past Reported Speech



To change a sentence in direct speech that is in the past tense to reported speech, you must also change the verb. One past tense reported verb is **said**.

Tom said, "I wanted to travel to China like Marco Polo."
 Tom said he had wanted to travel to China like Marco Polo.

Verb in Direct Speech	Verb Change in Reported Speech
present simple	simple past
present continuous	past continuous
present perfect	past perfect
present perfect continuous	past perfect continuous
simple past	past perfect
past continuous	past perfect continuous
past perfect	no change
past perfect continuous	no change
