Sometimes a writer describes two nouns by explaining how they are alike and how they are different. This is called writing that **compares**.



Earth and Mars

Earth and Mars are both planets. There are eight planets in our solar system and they all orbit around the sun. The land on Mars and Earth is alike. Both have mountains, valleys, volcanoes, and polar ice. Mars and Earth are both terrestrial planets. This means they have land. But there are many things about Earth and Mars that are different.

Earth is our home planet and has oceans of water and land called continents. Some people call Earth the "blue planet" because you can see the blue oceans from space. Earth is the only planet with life. There is one moon that orbits Earth.

Mars is smaller than Earth. It is very cold and dry on Mars and there is no life there. The land on Mars is covered in a red dust. This is why some people call Mars the "red planet." There are two moons that orbit around Mars. They are called Phobos and Deimos.
